Learning Log

Turn missed, guessed, and uncertain questions into a clear next move. After each practice set, add one row per question worth reviewing. Spend the most time in the “What I misunderstood” column — plain sentences, not codes.

How to use this log

1. Add a row for every question you missed, guessed on, or felt unsure about — one question per row.
2. Fill in the type and miss columns from the options below, then write what you misunderstood in your own words.
3. Choose one next practice move per row. Update the Status column as you review, practice, and retest.

Options for the columns

Each column uses a fixed set of options. Copy the chip text into the cell (in the Hub, the same options are drop-downs).
